Mentions of the settlement appear in Czech chronicles as early as 1309, when the settlement belonged to the brothers (probably of the Order of Teutonic Knights) and existed even before John of Luxembourg annexed the Cheb region to the Kingdom of Bohemia—long before Charles IV built the Charles Bridge, Karlštejn Castle, the Hradčany castle complex, and before he founded the Czech Technical University in Prague, and before he established the town of Karlovy Vary.

Over the years, Zelený Háj, formerly known as Hagengrün, became part of various municipalities. Between 1869 and 1976, it belonged to Vojtanov. Then, for a short period between 1976 and 1980, it became part of Františkovy Lázně. Between 1980 and 1991, Zelený Háj was not listed as part of any municipality. Since 1992, it has again been part of Vojtanov.

Despite its small size, Zelený Háj is an important part of the region and its history. Every corner of this village tells the story of its rich past and of the people who have lived and continue to live here.
